





The Road Death Investigation Manual (RDIM) was adopted by the UK Police Service to standardise investigative methods into fatal and suspected fatal collisions that occur on the road network. Amongst many features, the contribution that the road environment made to the incident was included within the primary investigation to ensure that a comprehensive report was available for prosecutors to consider what, if any, culpability by any one person or persons and any authorities existed.
